## **Cyclist Safety**

At this time of year, reducing daylight and inclement weather can lead to reduced visibility for cyclists.

Motorists and Cyclists can play a role in improving this situation, ensuring that everybody gets to and from work safely.

## **Cyclists**

- Make yourself as visible as possible use Hi-vis clothing / markings.
- Always wear a cycling helmet.
- Always make sure you have (and use) lights front and rear.

## **Motorists**

- Be extra vigilant regarding cyclists.
- Be patient if you have to slow down or wait for a cyclist then slow down and wait.
- Give cyclists enough time / space when overtaking / manoeuvring.

Common courtesy from both parties means we can both use the roads safely
