NS re	ad the following extract from October's Safety Bulletin prepared by RG:		
"A breakdown of the above shows that a disproportionately high number of 'more experienced' individuals have been injured this year compared to the 'higher risk' Phase 1 and Level 2 learners (i.e 10 versus 3). This is the complete opposite to what we normally see but I don't know why".			
NS re occur be ho	ated that there have been 6 accidents since the last report of which 4 were Phase 2 learners. equested that the representatives present to ask their groups if there was anything different ring which might help explain the recent rise in injury accidents. NS stated that he would also lding a meeting with the TO's to discuss with them whether they were aware of any issues that be causing the rise in the injury rate.		
NS co	ontinued to read from October's Safety Bulletin:		
2,663	positive note, we are now less than one day away from completing 6 years and 8 months (or 1,943 person hours) without a lost time or RIDDOR reportable injury which by any standard, is a remarkable achievement"
